

We offer loans, coaching, and guidance to people, businesses, nonprofits, and communities to enable them to own and preserve affordable homes, grow small businesses, access cost saving clean energy, and provide strong community services.

Our neighbors-investing-in-neighbors model turns donations and impact investor funds into loans and services for homeowners, small businesses, nonprofits, and communities. Since 1983, we have helped purchase or preserve over 11,000 affordable homes and added coaching and guidance loan services that help borrowers navigate repayment.

Bonnie joined the New Hampshire Community Loan Fund in 1998 and has helped develop the nonprofit organization's financial capacity as it grew from \$10 million in total assets under management to over \$200 million today.

The Community Loan Fund was one of the first Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFI) in the nation and has received industry awards and recognition for social impact, financial strength, and performance.

Prior to joining the New Hampshire Community Loan Fund, Bonnie worked for other nonprofit organizations in the areas of international development and



public policy. She holds a B.A. in International Studies from Stonehill College and a Certificate in Accounting from Franklin Pierce College.

Bonnie currently serves as treasurer on the Board of Trustees of Paraprofessional Healthcare Institute. PHI works to transform eldercare and disability services. The nonprofit fosters dignity, respect, and independence—for all who receive care, and all who provide it. As the nation's leading authority on the direct care workforce, PHI promotes quality direct care jobs as the foundation for quality care.
